



## Information Notice: ESAR Portal Enhancements

Effective October 3, 2010, U.S. Customs and Border Protection will deploy enhanced Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) capabilities related to Entry Summary, Accounts and Revenue (ESAR) that will provide new portal capabilities related to CBP Forms and Reports.

### **CBP Forms**

- ACE portal account holders who have the ability to select “portal” as their mode of communication will now also be able to view and respond to CBP Forms 28, 29 and 4647 via the ACE Portal for all entry summaries (that is, both ACS and ACE entry summaries). **Please note CBP can only post Forms to one Portal account.**

### **Reports**

- The Entry Summary Universe will be redesigned to make it easier to use and to provide additional flexibility when creating and modifying ACE Entry Summary reports. The redesign will resolve numerous incompatibility issues previously experienced when running Entry Summary reports. In addition, data objects in the Entry Summary Universe will now appear in alphabetical order within each report class and sub-class.
  - With the redesign of the Entry Summary Universe, ACE Entry Summary reports previously customized and saved to the user’s “Favorites” folder may not return the desired results. Users may need to run the saved reports using the “Modify” and “Edit Query” features of the reporting tool to refine the report.
  - As part of the redesign of the Entry Summary Universe, redundant data objects have been removed; data objects have been renamed and new data objects have been made available. Additional information on the redesigned universe will be included in Appendix B of the “Running ACE Reports for Importers, Brokers and Sureties User Guide” to assist users in customizing ACE Entry Summary reports.
  - Please note Account Management, Account Revenue, Authorized Data Extract, Reference and Transactions reports are not impacted by the redesign.
- Although users will see the new post summary correction data objects listed in the Entry Summary Universe, no data will be returned if selected at this time. CBP will issue a separate Information Notice to announce the deployment of EDI capabilities specific to the ABI processing of post summary corrections for entry summaries filed in ACE. Trade users will be notified via the Cargo Systems Messaging Service (CSMS) and the ACE
