





## Java Control Panel Setting to Suppress an Error While Running ACE Reports

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has become aware of an ACE Reports issue impacting users with the latest version of Java. CBP investigated the issue and learned of a setting in the Java Console to suppress the error message below:




To enable the Java setting, please follow these steps:

- Open **Java** from the **Control Panel** in your computer's operating system (e.g., Windows XP, Vista, 7 or 8)
- Once the **Java Control Panel** displays, click on the **Security** tab
- From the **Security** tab, locate the **Exception Site List** and click on the **Edit Site List** button





- When the **Exception Site List** dialogue box displays, click on the **Add** button
- Type the URL: **https://ace.cbp.dhs.gov** in the **Location** field and click on the **OK** button
- Click on the **OK** button again



After completing the configuration settings, please relaunch the ACE Reporting tool to run reports.
